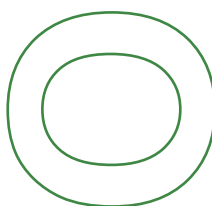
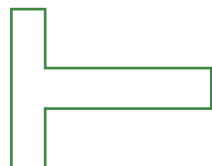
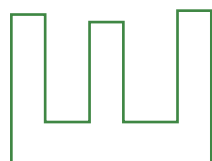




## Aizkorri Nature Reserve and the Road to Santiago de Compostela



Walking through the forests in the nature reserve from **Otzaurte** and making our way through the legendary cave of San Adrián, we will discover the remains of the ancient Roman way forming part of the stretch making its way through the Bay of Biscay of the Road to Santiago de Compostela (today we can still see the road followed by the pilgrims). We can climb Mount Aizkorri or enjoy the peace and quiet of the lower meadows, known as Urbía. Coming down over Otzaurte pass will bring us out at Zegama entrance to the Nature Reserve; a walk round the village will take us to the church (housing the mausoleum of the Carlist General Tomás de Zumalakarregi y la Cruz, the oldest in Gipuzkoa), a number of little chapels, ancient houses, the hand-made textile workshop and shop, unique in the Basque Country, Arkama Mill and the Wood Interpretation Centre.
